Welcome! We hope you enjoy this year's pool season. We ask that members help maintain a safe, fun, and efficiently managed pool environment. Please treat the pool area with the same care and respect you would your own home. Please PICK UP ALL TRASH. All swimmers and visitors must follow our established rules to insure everyone's safety and enjoyment.

Swimming Pool Rules & Information

HOURS

Our planned pool season is the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend through the Monday of Labor Day weekend. Hours of operation: 7:00 am to 9:00 pm (daylight). Hours may be adjusted as daylight shortens later in the season and conditions allow. Weekdays from 9:30 am to 10:30 am the pool is exclusively for Adult Water Aerobics & Lap Swimming. Restroom facilities are available from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.

ACCESS

Once we have your signed Application and payment you will be given a gate pass code.

Use your assigned MEMBER ONLY pass code to access the pool through the gate lock.

Do not give the pass code to nonmembers. If you can't open the gate, push "C" (for clear) before entering the code, if that doesn't work, contact the pool manager.

MEMBERS

No lifeguards will be present. Pool facilities are used at member's own risk.

All adult members must be able to show identification if asked by a Pool Committee person or their representative. Household memberships are for people living in your home or in college through age 23 – Otherwise they are guests and the guest fee is required (see below).

Please sign in at the log book just inside the gate. This is important!

No children under the age of 12 without adult supervision.

GUESTS & BEHAVIOR

Guests must be accompanied by the member and are limited as per the application unless approved by the pool committee. Fees are \$3.00 per guest per visit. Guest fees can be in the form of cash or check made payable to "Royal Oaks Pool Committee."

Note the number of guests and fees paid in the Sign-In book.

There is a locked drop box for guest fee payments. It will be emptied and recorded daily.

Persons in the pool area without memberships will be assessed a \$3.00 guest fee and (if a resident) will be asked to purchase a membership or leave the pool.

Each member is responsible for ensuring Guest Fees are being honored.

You are limited to six (6) guests per household membership per day. Exceptions may be granted by the Pool Committee.

Report repeat offenders and non-Royal Oaks persons to Maryville Police dispatch at 983-3620.

Please become familiar with fellow pool members. There is a directory of members on site.

Report major problems to the Pool Manager, Ben Ware at 865-621-6308.

Remember that we are a self-managed, volunteer pool committee. Please do not needlessly contact the manager.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

Do not park in the spaces beside the steps and the pool sidewalk. Those spots are for Royal Oaks operations staff only.

No glass allowed inside the pool area.

Pool parties only with Pool Committee approval.

A telephone is available at the pool house for **EMERGENCY USE ONLY!** as required by regulations. Do not attempt to operate any pool controls or equipment unless directed to do so by management. Please clean up after your visit.

Members assume all risks of personal and property protection.

Security devices such as cameras, alarms, or access control are for property protection of the pool facility only.

These devices are not intended to provide protection to members or their personal property.

Members acknowledge that security cameras may be recording pool area activities.

Pool membership is for use of the swimming pool ONLY. Other than the lower area bathrooms/showers, do not use other areas of the Royal Oaks Community Center.

The pool committee is a non-profit, volunteer group.

Rules, regulations and hours of operation are also posted at the pool.
